

## **ANTHONY OLIVERI, P.E.**

Anthony Oliveri has been employed with Dolph Rotfeld Engineering, P.C., since 1997 as Project Engineer, Project Manager and presently as Associate in the firm. Mr. Oliveri is responsible for the design and preparation of contract documents and Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plans (SWPPP) for many municipal and private infrastructure projects. He oversees our staff who perform construction inspection and administration for many projects.

Mr. Oliveri is currently managing projects at the South Westchester Executive Park in Yonkers including a number of Hotel and Office Building site plan developments and the proposed overall comprehensive stormwater management plan of the office park. He is also involved with the current East Branch Blind Brook Watershed Study in the Village of Rye Brook, evaluating flooding impacts in the watershed basin and the retrofitting of stormwater quantity and quality controls in the existing drainage system. Mr. Oliveri is also currently managing and principal designer for several stormwater management plans including a 15 acre subdivision development in the Town of Greenburgh; retrofitting of the existing leaf transfer station site for the Town of Greenburgh with stormwater quantity and quality practices; development of the Greenburgh Town DPW Yard SWPPP and Best Management Practices selection; he was also responsible for the design and construction management of several synthetic turf ball fields, including Haindl Field for the Town of Eastchester and Columbus Park for the Village of Port Chester. These projects each included unique design solutions with respect to stormwater quantity and quality issues and compliance with NYSDEC Phase II Regulations.

Mr. Oliveri manages the firm's responsibilities as consulting engineer to various municipalities in Westchester. These responsibilities include municipal engineering duties, capital projects implementation and Site Plan, Subdivision and Sediment and Erosion Control Plan reviews. In addition, projects that Mr. Oliveri has designed and managed include site plan development and stormwater management plan for the Yonkers Raceway/Empire City Video Lottery Terminal re-development. Design and construction of Public Works garages and yards for the Town of Mamaroneck and the Village of Ossining.

Mr. Oliveri works closely with government agencies as a representative of this firm including NYSDOT, the Westchester County Department of Health and Department of Public Works and NYSDEC.
