

## **DOLPH ROTFELD, P.E., F.NSPE, BCEE**

Dolph Rotfeld is the founder and principal of **Dolph Rotfeld Engineering, P.C.**, consulting engineers for environmental, civil and sanitary projects. He is actively involved and leads the staff in studies and designs mainly for public and select private clients. He specializes in consulting initially with the officials on municipal capital projects and infrastructure rehabilitation. For private clients, DRE has worked on all phases of development of commercial, industrial and residential land, implementation costs, optimum land use, traffic circulation systems, utility service and related facilities. Special care is taken to avoid conflicts of interest between public and private clients.

Dolph Rotfeld Engineering, P.C., has or is currently providing consulting services to several municipal clients, including the City of New Rochelle; the Villages of Ardsley, Elmsford, Rye Brook; the Towns of New Castle, Greenburgh, Eastchester, and Westchester County. The firm also currently serves as Village Engineer for Mount Kisco, Port Chester, Pelham Manor and Sleepy Hollow.

He was President of that Society's Westchester Chapter, and then President of the New York State Society.
